Tamil Nadu SC/ST Startup Fund enhanced to Rs. 50 Crore in 2023-24 Highlights of TN Budget announcements for Startups

The Hon'ble Minister for Finance and Human Resources Management Dr. Palanivel Thiaga Rajan presented the State Budget for the year 2023-24 in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on March 20, 2023. The following are the Startup and Startup ecosystem related announcements made by the minister in his budget speech.



Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises

- Tamil Nadu SC/ST Startup Fund, a first of its kind fund forStartups founded and run by entrepreneurs from the SC/ST communities, has been enhanced to Rs. 50 Crore in 2023-24 from Rs. 30 Crore in 2022-23.
- Tamil Nadu has one of the largest number of business incubators in the country. With a view to supporting business incubators who propose to specialise in areas like climate tech, rural tech, agri tech and marine tech, StartupTN will assist them in raising funds from various sources to set up Centres of Excellence and will also bear up to 40 per cent of the cost of such upgradation. A separate vertical will be created in StartupTN to further the incubator ecosystem in the State.
- In the current year, under the New Entrepreneur cum Enterprise Development Scheme (NEEDS), sanction has been given for subsidies worth Rs. 144 Crore. This is a new milestone in the implementation of the scheme so far. Tamil Nadu is the only State which has mandated that all Public Sector Enterprises be registered with the Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS) Platform, assuring timely bill payment to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises.

Women and Children

• Women entrepreneurs continue to face difficulties in accessing adequate, timely credit and marketing of products. To address these challenges, the Government will establish an exclusive "Start-up Mission" for women. This mission will facilitate women entrepreneurs in all aspects of their business.

Higher Education and Skill Development

The Government proposes to establish a world class skill centre named "Tamil Nadu World Innovation and Skill Training Hub"
(TN-WISH) at Ambattur at a cost of Rs. 120 Crore with the objective of providing skill training to trainers in ITIs and polytechnics and to create a highly skilled workforce. The hub will provide training in advanced technologies such as Mechatronics, Internet of Things, Advanced Automobile Technology, Precision Engineering and Advanced Welding.

Industries

• To consolidate the benefits from these investments, guided by the vision to steer Tamil Nadu towards a one trillion-dollar economy by 2030, the next Global Investors Meet (GIM) will be organised in Chennai on 10th and 11th January 2024. This will be a platform that will showcase the investment friendly climate prevailing in the State and also its immense strengths and attractiveness as an investment destination. It will also facilitate our industries, MSMEs and Startups to connect with the global markets and investors. An allocation of Rs. 100 crore has been made for the Global Investors Meet.

Information Technology

To promote Tamil Nadu as a global hub for IT/ITeS and to meet the increasing demand for quality office space, the Government will
establish "Tamil Nadu Tech City (TNTech city)" at Chennai, Coimbatore and Hosur. To facilitate functioning of IT/ITeS, GCC, FinTech
and Startups, the TN Tech city will house a centre of excellence, innovation plaza, convention centres, recreation facilities and other
necessary infrastructure.


Agriculture Budget 2023-24

The Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Thiru. M.R.K. Panneerselvam presented the Agriculture Budget for the year 2023-24 in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on March 21, 2023. The following are the Startup and Startup ecosystem related announcements made by the minister in his budget speech.



Agro based industries in the Cauvery delta zone:

- In the last Agriculture Budget, the area between Tiruchirappalli and Nagapattinam was
 declared as Agro Industrial Corridor and a detailed project report has been prepared to set up
 the Agro Industrial corridor in the Cauvery delta Zone to enhance the income of the farm
 families and create employment opportunities for the youth.
- Enhanced incentive packages, market linkages, expert guidance and single window facilities
 will be provided to the aspiring entrepreneurs to start agro-based food processing industries.
 To facilitate efficient ways of storage, processing and marketing, new industrial estates will
 be developed with common facilities.
- A new Regional Startup Hub will be created in Thanjavur by the Tamil Nadu Startup and Innovation Mission (StartupTN) to promote agro technological innovations in Cauvery Delta Region.
- Through this agro-industrial corridor, the projects of various sectors related to agriculture will be coordinated and effectively implemented at an outlay of Rs. 1,000 Crore in the next five years.






StartupTN Investor Connect











